



SUWA seeks an enthusiastic intern for Fall 2021!

Working with our Utah Grassroots Organizer on a variety of grassroots campaigns, the intern will complement organizers as they conduct activities throughout Utah to demonstrate support for protecting America's Red Rock Wilderness as a significant step towards mitigating the climate crisis and protecting biodiversity. Social distancing permitting, activities may include, but are not limited to: coordinating letter writing and virtual meetings between SUWA member activists and Utah Members of Congress, coordinating distribution sites for SUWA's Redrock Wilderness newsletter, coordinating tabling activities at festivals and fairs, and directed public forum writing on timely issues, as permitted.

This internship is based in Salt Lake City at SUWA's headquarter office, 425 E 100 S, or online, and runs roughly early-Sept to early-Dec 2021. The intern reports to SUWA's Utah Grassroots Organizer. Stipend \$1,000 as a recipient of the Dr. Norman Weissman Internship for Preservation of Wild & Scenic Utah. Hours are part-time but flexible, roughly 15 hours/wk.

This is a great opportunity to gain valuable experience into the day-to-day functions of a nonprofit organization leading one of the most recognized conservation campaigns in the country, including wilderness legislation, national monuments and legal actions. The experience offers insight into environmental campaign planning, education, organizing and activism. The intern will take from the experience a new found, or reinvigorated, passion for activism to Protect Wild Utah. Interested applicants should send a one-page



cover letter summarizing the reasons why you're the best candidate, where this opportunity fits into your education, and describing what you intend to do with the experience.
