This internship will give candidates a unique opportunity to work within a nonprofit organization and be on the front lines of the fight to conserve Utah's water.

This candidate will assist the Utah Rivers Council on their various campaigns and initiatives including the Great Salt Lake, the Colorado River, and more. Individuals with a variety of skills and interests are encouraged to apply.

Minimum qualifications

We are looking for candidates preferably in their senior year of their college education and studying Environmental and Sustainability Studies, Geography, GIS, Natural Resource Management (Parks, Recreation, and Tourism), or any other related and applicable fields. This position requires strong written and verbal communication skills and an ability to work with various stakeholders. The ideal candidate is willing to take on leadership roles and work both independently and with a team.

We are looking for a candidate who wants to utilize their creativity and expertise to encourage Utahns to engage in water conservation. A strong desire to advocate on behalf of rivers, lakes and the fish and wildlife species that depend upon them is a must. Candidates should demonstrate in their application materials that they have a basic working knowledge of the challenges faced in Utah's water sector and the scope of natural resource challenges facing the American West.
